In a bid to avoid traffic accidents on BRTS corridor owing to movement of people across the street, the Indore Development Authority (IDA) decided to construct foot overbridges at vulnerable places like the zoo and Orbit Mall.

This decision has been taken at a meeting presided over by collector Akash Tripathi on Wednesday. The officials also took decisions regarding bicycle operations through public-private partnership (PPP model), starting E-auto facility and extending ibus service till Pipliyapala Park.

Tripathi stressed on including suitable spots in front of zoo, C-21 Mall, Vishnupuri Bholaram Ustad Marg and Orbit Mall as places to be finalised for constructing the
